Call for Proposals

The ISSA (International Studies Schools Association) is soliciting presentations for its 5th Annual Conference, to be held February 16 – 19, 2006, in Raleigh-Durham, North Carolina. The ISSA Conference is the leading forum for the K-12 community to learn, share, and interact on how to add a global dimension to every discipline at every grade level.

Proposals Must be Postmarked by July 15, 2005

The Planning Committee seeks proposals that:

- Promote global perspectives at the K-12 level
- Promote global perspectives in math, science, language arts, humanities, business, economics, the arts, etc.
- Provide real world examples and connections
- Present research on education and global studies
- Support instructional innovations for improving international education at every grade level
- Promote ways for educators and administrators to build support for international education among parents, the community, and the media

You may request to make a presentation in either of the following formats:

- **Sessions (60 minutes):** Informative presentation that includes opportunities for presenter-audience interaction and participant-participant interaction
- **Workshops or Panels (90 minutes):** A more intensive format with presentation followed by interaction, practice of applications, and hands-on experiences

Commercial Solicitation: ISSA has a strong commitment to high standards of scholarship and professional development. If you represent a commercial venue, your presentation must be educational in nature, and not a forum to sell products.

Presenter Registration: All presenters are required to register for the conference by **January 13, 2006**.

Audiovisual: At the request of the primary presenter, ISSA will provide, at additional charge, audiovisual equipment for presentation rooms. Please indicate your audiovisual needs on this form. Do not include any fees with the form; you will be informed of the costs and then billed if your proposal is accepted. The primary presenter will incur the cost of ordering additional equipment.
